
BACKGROUND

To continue promoting well-being and healthy life style for the young learners we will provide Sport uniform for G7 & G10.


Additionally we will launch the year with Sport-Day activities for each separate schools.

- Grades 7 and Grade 10.

We will keep providing trolley bags with stationaries for G1 as part of the School kit initiative.

In total, 10 schools covered: 5 girls schools (Three elementary, One intermediate, and One secondary), and 5 boys schools (Three elementary, one intermediate and one secondary school).




- Posters and stationaries drop off box were sit up in Big Tamimi Supermarket.
